Day 1

Afternoon: Arrival in Limoges at the beginning of the afternoon. Private visit of the Enamel House's gallery, with a film about enamel history and techniques; then a workshop where you can make your own locket (you take it home). Settling in to your two-star hotel in the centre of Limoges, dinner and sleep.

Day 2

Morning: Free visit of the A. Dubouché National Porcelain Museum: 12,000 ceramic pieces, amongst which is a collection of Limoges Porcelain. It's the only one of its kind in the world, ranging from the beginning of Porcelain to contemporary production.

Afternoon: Private visit of the Moulin du Got (mill). You'll make all-rag paper by hand and you'll prepare and letterpress a card on paper made in the mill. Departure at the end of the afternoon.

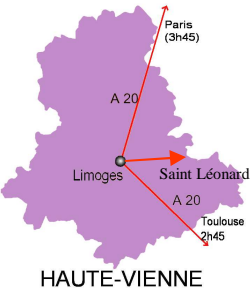
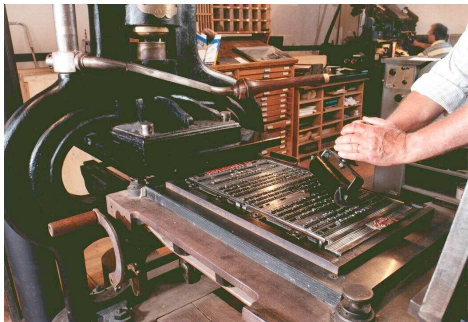
